

MEDSPORTS Swim School Rules

Normal Pool Rules

- 1. Strictly NO PARKING on school premises . Please do not try to enter the school car park as this is prohibited. Please Park elsewhere outside school gates.
- 2. No parents on poolside unless invited.
- 3. All children must wear a swim hat/cap (no exceptions). Swim cap is available for sale on site. Please Ask coordinator for pricing.
- 4. No jewellery or watches to be worn in the pool.
- 5. Strictly no running in the poolside area.
- 6. No food and drink allowed on the premises (including changing/waiting areas).
- 7. All shoes (including those of parents) to be removed when near the poolside area to keep dust and dirt from contaminating pool water.
- 8. No baby strollers in the changing rooms at any time. Please, if you change a diaper for babies, take it home with you, there are no facilities for diapers disposal on site.

COVID-19 Updated Rules

We have some additional rules in place in order to meet Government guidance for swimming during the COVID-19 pandemic:

- •Swimmers need to arrive already changed into their swim wear and with as little as possible additional clothes on).
- Swimmers can only enter the swimming pool grounds five (5) minutes before their lesson time (and not before).



- Swimmers must bring their own bag containing their towel and clothes for a quick change after the lesson.
- Individual Shower stalls are available before and after swimming.
- All clothes (including shoes) must be stored in the swimmer's bag during the lesson.
- •Adults accompanying children into the swimming pool building must wear a face mask (unless exempt) and use the hand sanitiser provided.
- Parents/ Guardians are allowed to watch from poolside or the waiting/viewing area but must maintain 2m social distancing and wear a face covering.
- If parents/guardians prefer to wait outside they should be on hand to help with caps and goggles if needed.

To keep everyone safe, please cooperate!

- •Swimmers enter and exit the pool on the same side as the changing room they used.
- •Swim coaches will teach from the side of the pool where possible, but may enter the pool to help with nervous/young children.

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
